The design produced throughout the period of Hitler's rule, whether graphic, product or industrial, mirrors his triumphs and failures, whether in the form of the Olympic Games and the Volkswagen or alternatively propaganda and the total mobilisation of the economy to support the war efforts. This dense collection of historical images collects together all manner of different 'designs' generated in Germany throughout this period, and include advertisement and propaganda posters, products, air-force, navy and military advertisements for different materials and products, along with industrial design.
